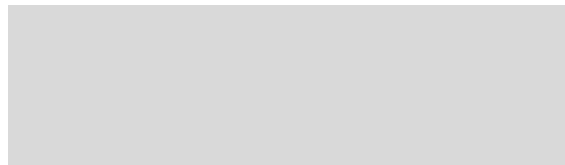
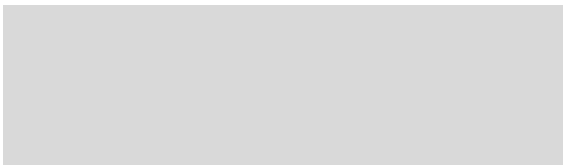


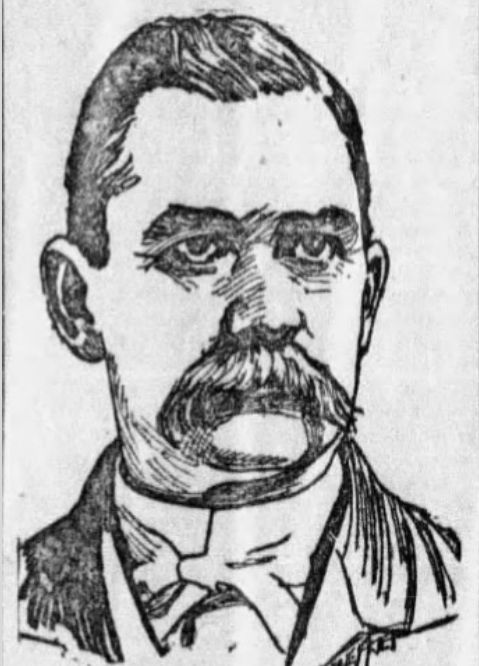
Happy Labor Day!

Observed the first Monday in September, Labor Day is an annual celebration recognizing the achievements of American workers. First celebrated September 5, 1882, in New York City, Labor Day became a federal holiday in 1894.

Strategically situated on the Miami River and home to a variety of factories, it's no surprise that Dayton became a center for labor unions in the early 20th century; at the heart of a movement which would go on to establish the way American workers engage with their employers in the modern day.

Join Woodland this fall for our upcoming concert series with Viva La Strings.

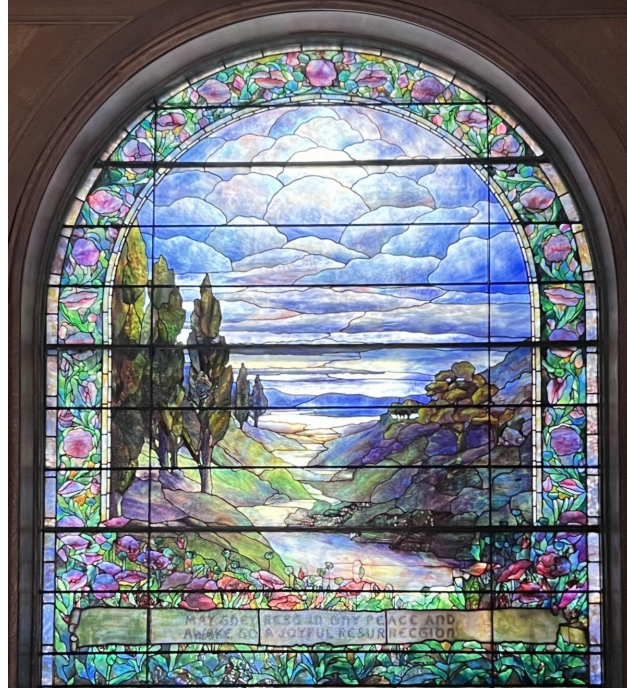
Each concert will feature a string quartet exploring the best of classical music.

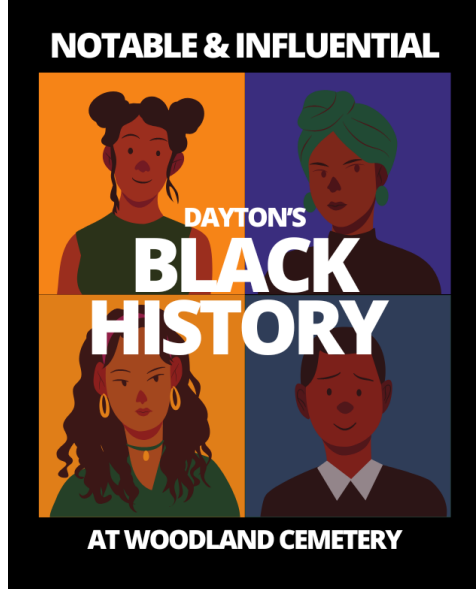

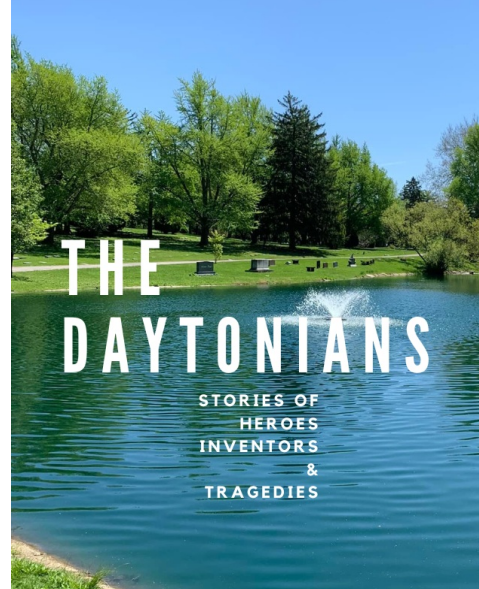

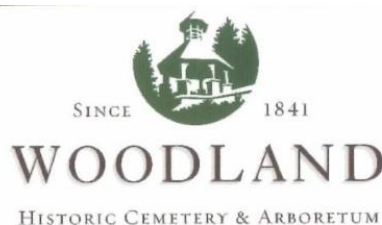
We welcome walkers, runners, and wanderers -- leashed dogs & school groups.
