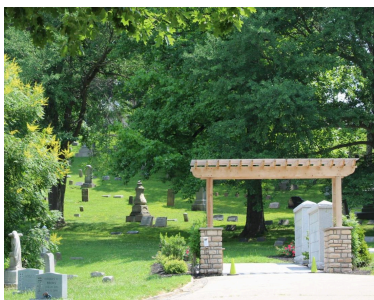

And we're still growing! The cemetery's acreage includes enough undeveloped land to accommodate another 100 years of active operations.

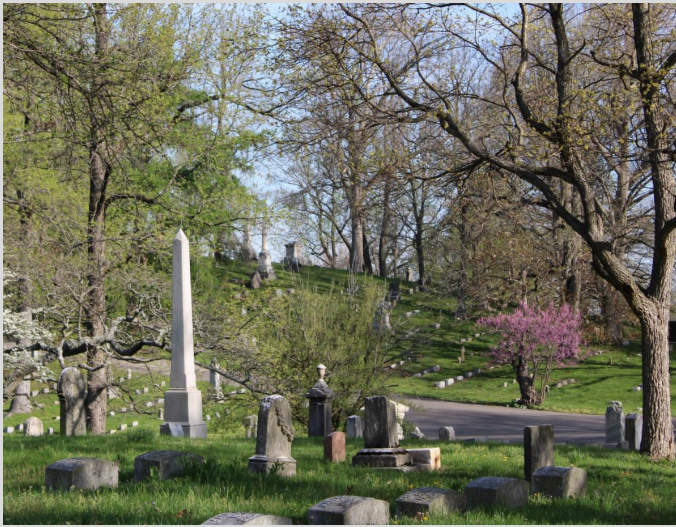

Garden cemeteries like Woodland are designed to appeal to the living as well as honor the dead.

For over 100 years, we've been among the best spots in the city for a peaceful stroll. Home to more than 3,000 trees, Woodland is recognized as one of the area's finest Level 2 Arboretums. Many of its trees are more than a century old and support a variety of local wildlife—especially birds.

Woodland is a great place to explore local history! Woodland's rolling hills are dotted with more than 100,000 monuments—ranging from rugged boulders to classical sculpture—commemorating the lives of people who helped to shape the Dayton we know today. Look for our new QR codes at selected landmarks to learn more about notable Daytonians of the past!

For architecture buffs, the cemetery's Romanesque gateway, historic chapel (home to one of the finest original Tiffany windows in the country!) and Administrative office, are certain to be of interest. Completed in 1889, and still in use today, these local landmarks were added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1979.

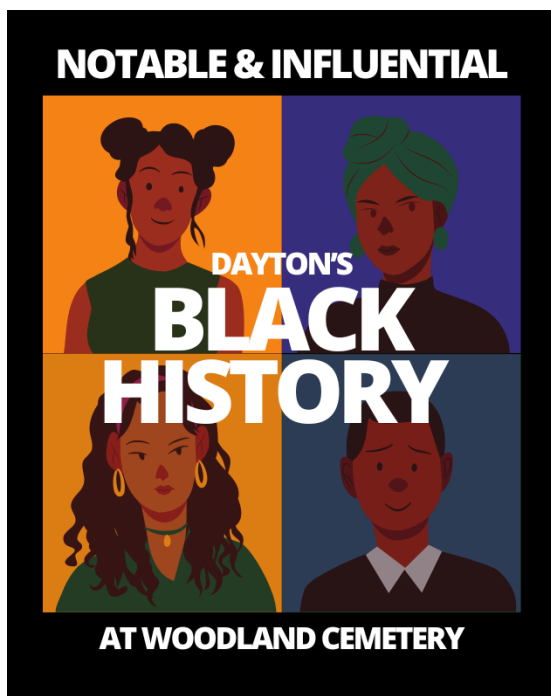

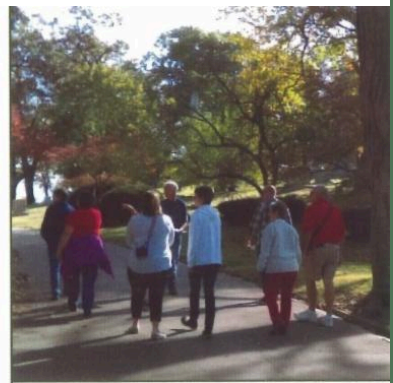
