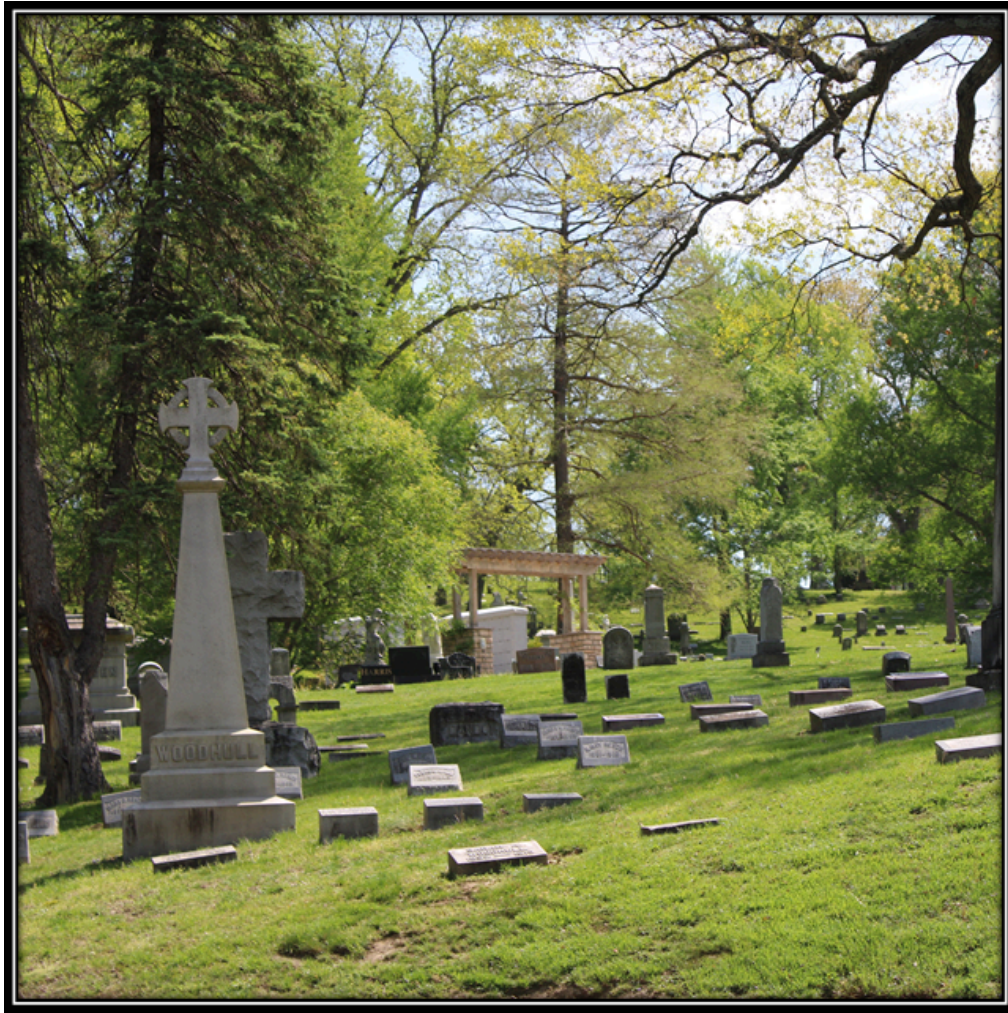

Planning Your Visit

This year, while our nation commemorates its 250th birthday, Woodland Cemetery will mark its 185th anniversary. Milestones like these offer us the opportunity to reflect on the variety of people who built, cared for, and entrusted their loved ones to this cemetery in particular, and to the project of the United States of America in general.

For nearly two centuries, Woodland has served as a place where those who came before us are honored and preserved with dignity. When we look back on the span of years that led us here, we realize that local and national history are deeply connected—not just by static things like monuments & books, but through the lives of the veterans, civic leaders, educators, inventors, artists, business owners, public servants, families, and neighbors whose stories helped shape the world we know today.

As Woodland expands into its undeveloped property, we continue to explore new and innovative burial options that reflect our legacy.

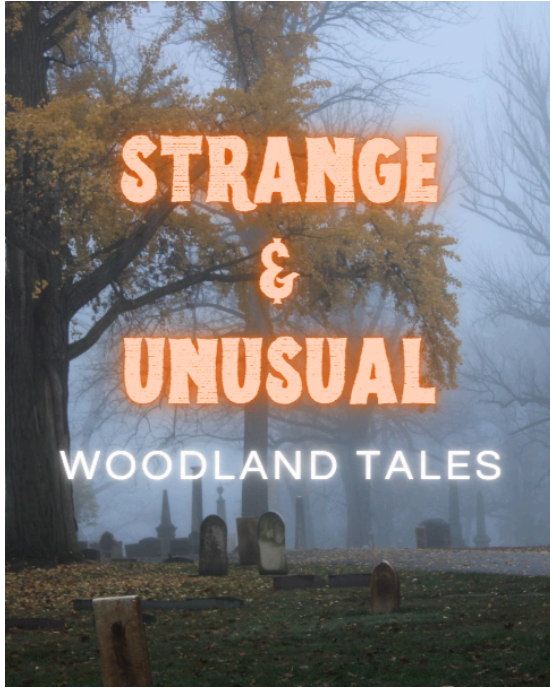

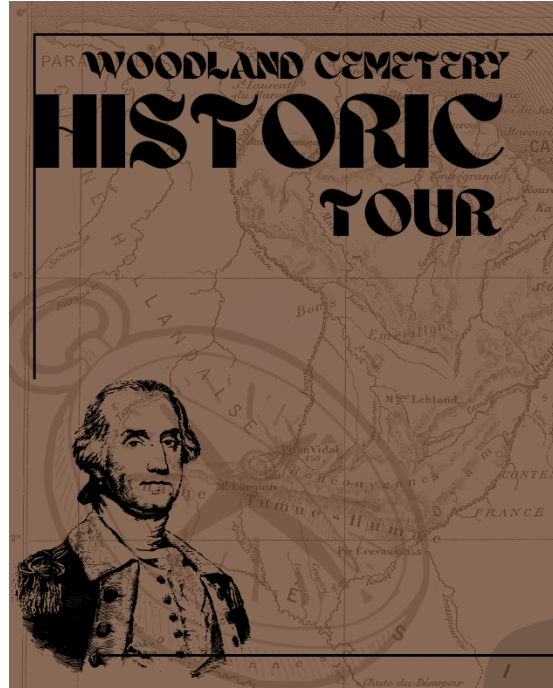
Winding paths will be bordered by perennial plantings that gently embrace the area, creating a peaceful environment for cremation burials nestled within nature's harmony.
