Woodland Cemetery and Arboretum invites you to one of our most unique events: Woof Walk!

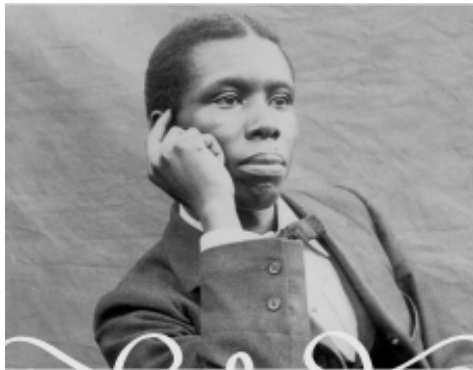
Dogs, you can take your human on a guided tour through Woodland Cemetery!

The Charity's Children Project, in partnership with Woodland Historic Cemetery and Arboretum, presents the Higgins Garden Dedication and installation of the Jewelina Galloway Higgins National Votes for Women Trail Historic Marker funded by the William G. Pomeroy Foundation.

Born in Dayton, Ohio, Jewelia Ann Galloway Higgins inherited a legacy rooted in early Black settlement, the Underground Railroad, and generations of activism.

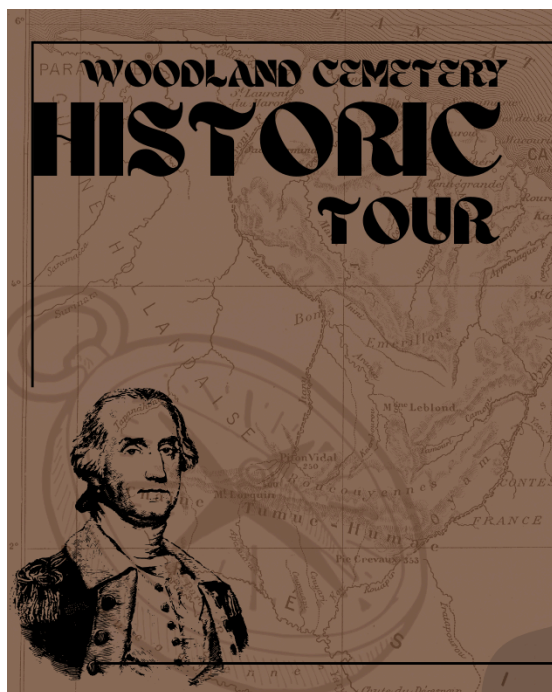

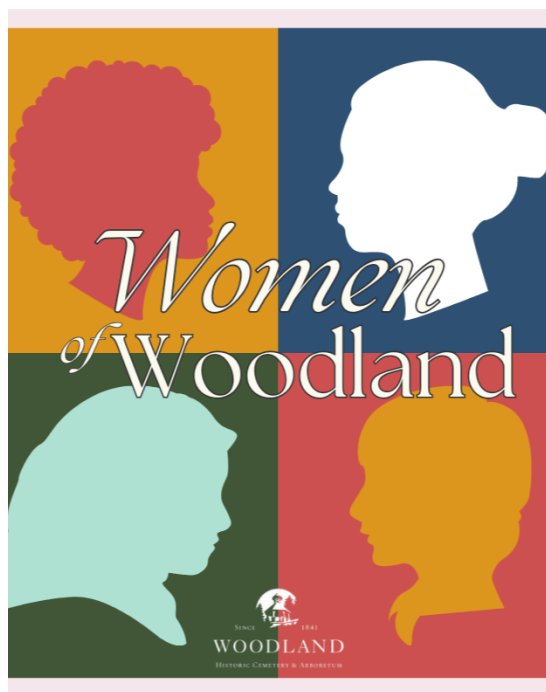
